

Brothers and Sisters,

This document is a housekeeping measure that takes away the jeopardy of having two home terminals unless you put yourself in that position by bidding other than your home terminal. You may bid to any list to keep up qualifications, or that is closer to your home. The carrier already can establish supplemental list anywhere they would like under rule 19. This just lays out how it is to be managed.

Example before this agreement if your home terminal was LB and your got called for NY you did not get DH to NY, now you do. The same would be true with the Hoboken supplemental list. By having more terminals you have a better chance for getting DH. The regular guaranteed Newark Extra List is a good example of this.

Also you do not have to take any assignment not out of your home terminal and if you refuse work out of your terminal the penalty is the same as always under rule 19.

“(e.) Except when they are on assigned vacation or authorized to be absent from duty, Engineers who are marked up on a Relief Day List and miss two successive calls shall have their names removed from the list. They shall not be permitted to make written application again for a Relief Day List for thirty (30) days.”
